

# CGS take on bus garage replanting scheme in East London

Building on our successful SuDS project in Central London, Chevron Green Services was commissioned to deliver a replanting scheme for Walthamstow Bus Garage.

## The Challenge

With no planting plan included in the original drawings, we had to develop a scheme from scratch. The garage was also set to reopen imminently following redevelopment, leaving us with a tight timeframe for plant delivery and installation.

## The Solution

We provided a full design and installation service, balancing aesthetics with practical drainage solutions to manage excess rainwater.

Collaboration was key, and we worked closely with TKJV to ensure the scheme was completed ahead of the grand reopening. Our dedicated team of two worked across two shifts, preparing the site, planting, and laying mineral mulch.

Given the tight deadline, the team went the extra mile - staying late across both shifts to complete the project on time.





## Sustainability benefits

The scheme included rain gardens designed to prevent flooding by efficiently draining excess water. The planting selections ensure the space remains visually appealing year-round while requiring minimal maintenance to sustain effective water management.
