

Routine plot maintenance work on the M25

CPS presented our team with a package of plot works of varying specifications including fence line clearance, ensuring trees and vegetation were a safe distance back from the carriageway, removal of hazardous trees and thinning of the current stock levels.

The Solution

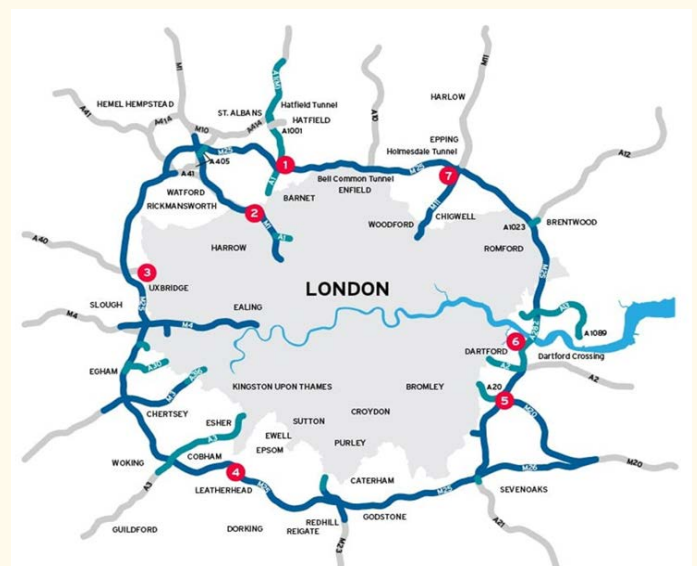

The varying specifications required the site teams to adapt their approach to the work, often using tracked machinery to access sites without the need for traffic management which reduces the overall cost to our client.

The teams often overcome daily challenges with access to site, the specification of work required and the need to undertake some work under traffic management for the safety of the travelling public and the site staff.

Our teams worked with CPS capturing work and site information using their works database for efficient recording of data rather than transferring between two databases.

CPS score the completion of works against target completion dates which can impact future workload, therefore our team's efficient planning has led to a consistent positive score and future order book.

The photos demonstrate grassland management work completed in accordance with M25 DBFO detailed specifications:

- Cut all grass and other herbaceous vegetation to a height no more than 100mm from ground level.
- Crown lifting of trees to 2m to allow sunlight to the ground.
- Spread all cuttings evenly across the grass.
